HOW TO GET THERE

January Monthly Party:

Mountain View Masonic Hall, 890 Church Street, Mountain View

DIRECTIONS: Directions: From 280: exit at S. El Monte Avenue, to Foothill Expressway. Right on Foothill Expressway, left on Miramonte Avenue, across El Camino Real W., to S. Shoreline Blvd. Turn right onto Church Street.

From 101: Exit at Moffett Blvd. Follow Moffett Blvd. south to Central Expressway. Cross Central Expressway on to Castro Street. Turn right onto Church Street (5 blocks).

Park in the lot behind the building or on the street.

San Rafael Masonic Hall, 1010 Lootens Place at 4th Street, San Rafael, 94901

DIRECTIONS: From 101 Northbound, take the "Central San Rafael" exit. Continue straight on Irwin Street (a short frontage road parallel to freeway). Turn left onto 4th Street. Turn Right onto Lootens Place.

From 101 Southbound take the "Central San Rafael" exit. Stay straight on Hetherton Street (a short frontage road parallel to freeway). Turn Right onto 4th Street. Turn Right onto Lootens Place.

Lootens Place ends across from a public parking lot. Nearby street parking is also available.

Public Transit Directions (Thanks to Donald Robertson):

Take Golden Gate Transit Bus 70 or 80 from the Transbay Terminal at 1st & Mission in San Francisco, to San Rafael Transit Center at 3rd and Hetherton. Walk 4 blocks to Lootens Place, turn right, and walk one block to 4th.
